

Dear Parent/Guardian

At every orchestra rehearsal a tuck shop operates and is staffed by volunteer parents. We desperately need additional volunteers in order to make the task easier for all involved. The commitment can be one day or half a day and there is no need to buy tuck, all is provided, all that needs doing is setting up, selling and clearing away. Parents normally do the shop in pairs so you will not be left on your own. If we have enough volunteers it makes it an easy job and the commitment will be less for all concerned.

The tuck shop operates not only to provide additional food for your children but helps stop them going off-site at lunch time. It is a very valuable service, please help.

The Music Service must ensure that any volunteers working near children have CRB clearance. Obtaining CRB clearance incurs no cost to the parents or the Music Service. However, any parents wishing to help must complete a form and obtain clearance before they can work at the tuck shop. This process can take up to one month.

If a volunteer already has an enhanced CRB clearance issued for working with children and young people in Lancashire and it has been issued within the last three years, this is acceptable, but the Music Service would need to see a copy of the CRB disclosure document.
